Max Tuck circulated a list of the applicants as of February 8, consisting of 20 fully paid, and 4 who were to submit the fees through the mail. From the list of members 6 were selected to be contacted by George Grummett for possible membership on the Management Committee.

Max Tuck is to give Bill Stephenson an up-to-date list of the members to circulate with the notice; and also to provide a "questionnaire" for the members based on those that were circulated in the past by the Probus Club of Burlington.

Bill Stephenson and Max Tuck were authorized to open a bank account in the Name of the "Probus Club of Burlington Lakeshore", to deposit the \$1450 membership fees that had been received to date, and to act as signing officers.

George Grummett undertook to obtain speakers for the April and May meetings.

George Grummett also expressed that there we should obtain stationary, membership cards and membership tags as soon as possible.

A "letter of thanks" to Len Milner, President of Lakeshore Rotary for founding the Club was to be delayed until a permanent President was selected.
