This fees increase will become effective with the start of our next fiscal year.

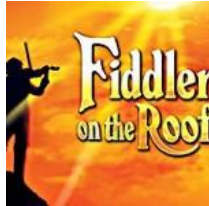
Collection of your fees will begin at the September meeting and are due no later than the October meeting.
