Guest Speaker - Cdr. Robert Williamson (Retired)



Robert Williamson was born and educated in East Hamilton. He received an Honours BA Degree in Geography from McMaster University in 1962 and a BEd from the University of Toronto. He is a retired

Hamilton Secondary School Administrator and former Commanding Officer of H.M.C.S. Star. During his tenure as commanding officer, the Hamilton Division won the Admiral E. R. Mainguy Trophy as the most improved naval division in Canada.

Having been appointed to the Hamilton Historical Board in 1999, and the Joint Plaquing Sub Committee in 2000 as a volunteer, he is the longest serving member of the Board. However, his active involvement in the promotion and preservation of Hamilton's history and heritage goes back almost 25 years when he gratuitously created his famous "Hamilton Then and Now" slide program in response to a Ministry of Education directive to promote the Ontario bicentennial in our schools. Having caught the attention of local historians, he was invited to join the Head of the Lake Historical Society and the Board of Education Archives Committee in 1991.

Commander Williamson will be talking about the Scourge and Hamilton - sailing ships which capsized and sank during a sudden squall in the early morning of August 8, 1813, with a loss of over 50 lives, while stationed off Port Dalhousie.


