Behavioural Neurosciences at McMaster University and St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton. There, he directs both the Peter Boris Centre for Addictions Research and the Michael G. DeGroote Centre for Medicinal Cannabis Research, where his research investigates diverse aspects of addiction and medical cannabis.

To date, Dr. MacKillop's research program has generated more than 350 peer-reviewed publications and other works. This work has been recognized by awards from the Society for Addiction Psychology, the Research Society on Alcoholism, and the American Psychological Association and been funded by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research, Health Canada, and the National Institutes of Health.

Dr. MacKillop trained as a clinical psychologist at Binghamton University and Brown University.
